

elcome to a singular Frank Lloyd Wright-inspired custom built home in Franklin Township's charming Pittstown. Featured on the front page of national publications including (2001) Better Homes and Garden, Fine Homebuilding magazine, this storybook home exudes modern charm on nearly nine wooded acres. Offered for the first time by the original owner, this 2000-built residence with a 2005 addition provides a sun-splashed floor plan of over 4,000 square-feet. The flexible layout offers four bedrooms and four full baths, with expansive spaces for entertaining or relaxing. Finished in cedar clapboard and shingles, serene views are enjoyed from a wraparound cedar porch, cedar deck and paver patio. Established landscaping and mature trees create a peaceful setting.

Highlights of the flowing floor plan include oak hardwood floors, trim and baseboards, solid six-panel stained pine doors, two gas fireplaces, window walls, arched doorways, abundant closet and storage space, neutral paint colors, recessed lighting and wall sconces. Notable gathering areas such as a gourmet center island kitchen, fireside great room, formal dining room, first level private den/ fourth bedroom, gracious primary suite and multi-room addition over the threecar garage set this home apart. Surrounded by gorgeous scenery, this residence is set extremely far back from the road at the end of a 1/3-mile paved drive. A double set of Mission-style doors with glass insets reveals the oak-floored foyer with a handsome style wood staircase and views into some of the adjacent gathering spaces. The dining room lined in crown moldings is an elegant spot for special occasions, while the expansive yet intimate great room's focal point is a river rock-faced propane and wood-burning fireplace flanked by wood cabinetry. Perfect for casual get-togethers, the great room's dramatic window wall frames bucolic views of the acreage. A den/fourth bedroom and direct access to the full bath, is tucked behind a set of double glass doors, where a picture window overlooks natural panoramas.

In the gourmet kitchen, desirable details include oak floors, stained birch cabinets, and an entertainment size center island topped in granite with breakfast bar seating. An impressive collection of stainless steel appliances from GE Café





SeriesTM, Sub-ZeroTM and KitchenAidTM streamline meal prep. The adjacent breakfast room presents additional counter space, a pantry closet, an elongated transom-topped window wall, charming window seat and an atrium door to the wraparound porch for warm weather dining. This part of the home also has a full bath featuring a tile shower, a convenient laundry room and access to the attached garage.

Added in 2005, a 777-square foot addition set above the three-car garage is arranged with an airy loft featuring oak floors, a carpeted leisure/sitting room offering two double door closets, a home office filled with natural light from its picture window, and a full bath designed with a soaking tub, half-tiled slate tiled walls, slate tiled floors, white birch double sink vanity with granite counters and a linen closet. Upstairs, the generously-sized primary suite is an indulgent retreat with a bedroom featuring towering ceilings, a gas fireplace, transom-topped arched window wall, window seat, sitting area and an enormous windowed walk-in closet. A spa-like primary bath presents an oversized tile shower enclosed by clear glass with dual sprays and seat, a double sink vanity capped in granite, a JacuzziTM jetted tub, private commode and vaulted ceiling. Two additional bedrooms on this level feature walk-in closets and share a full bath.

Historic Pittstown is in Franklin Township, a 23-square-mile municipality where farm stands, vintage homes and wide open spaces lend additional charm to the gently winding roadways. Sited in an old stone building, the Pittstown Inn is a celebrated gourmet restaurant offering contemporary American specialties in the middle of this quaint hamlet. Centrally situated about halfway between Manhattan and Philadelphia, Franklin combines the best of countryside living with easy access to suburban and metropolitan amenities. Serving Pittstown residents is North Hunterdon High School in Annandale, a nationally-recognized Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.
